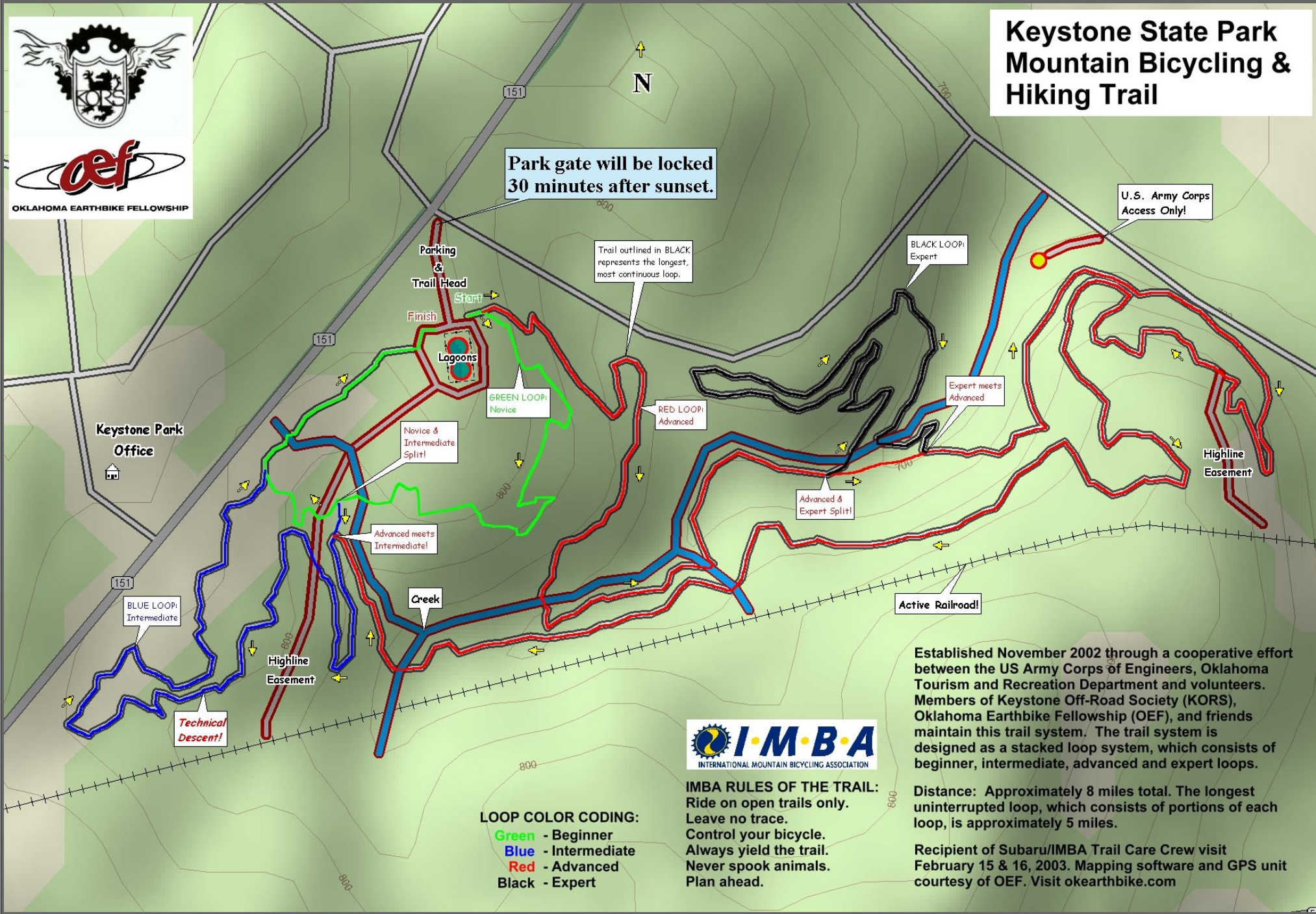

Established November 2002 through a cooperative effort between the US Army Corps of Engineers, Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department and volunteers. Members of Keystone Off-Road Society (KORS), Oklahoma Earthbike Fellowship (OEF), and friends maintain this trail system. The trail system is designed as a stacked loop system, which consists of beginner, intermediate, advanced and expert loops.



IMBA RULES OF THE TRAIL:
Ride on open trails only.
Leave no trace.
Control your bicycle.
Always yield the trail.
Never spook animals.
Plan ahead.

LOOP COLOR CODING:
Green - Beginner
Blue - Intermediate
Red - Advanced
Black - Expert

Distance: Approximately 8 miles total. The longest uninterrupted loop, which consists of portions of each loop, is approximately 5 miles.
